**(Temporary prohibition of vehicles) Order 2020**

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, hereby makes the following order:

1. This Order will come into operation on the 23rd April 2020 and will remain in force for eighteen months. All traffic will be prohibited from using Mousie Lane for a distance of approximately 239 metres.
2. The works are expected to commence on **1st May 2020** and the restrictions will apply when indicated by traffic signs.
3. Except as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person will cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait along the lengths of road specified in schedules to this Order
4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order will apply to:
  - Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform;
  - Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles.
  - Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

**Statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order**

- a) because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road; or
- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.
