Upgrading the footpath (WL 2/11) to a bridleway from Point A, at the county road near Yeanon Cottages (approximately ST 0586 3337) to Point B (approximately ST 0664 3343) at the junction with the ORPA a short distance west of the wireless station in the parish of Brompton Ralph.

The route's width is twenty feet wide, as specified in the Inclosure award.
