

**Somerset County Council

Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles**

Notice is hereby given that Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended intends to make an Order, the effect of which will be to introduce the following temporary traffic restrictions as detailed in the Schedule below.

This Order will come into operation on 19th day of March 2020 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The effect of which will be to introduce a Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles in the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order. The restrictions will apply when indicated by traffic signs.

The works are expected to start on the 24th day of March 2020 until the 9th day of April 2020.

Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles**

Moor Lane, South Petherton	From its junction with Harp Road, westwards for 290 metres. The proposed date of the closure is 24th March 2020 for 10 days
Bridge Road, South Petherton	For its entire length. The proposed date of the closure is 24th March 2020 for 10 days
South Harp, South Petherton	For its entire length. The proposed date of the closure is 02nd April 2020 for 8 days

**Lower Stratton,
South Petherton**

For its entire length.
The proposed date of the closure is **02nd April 2020 for 8 days**

**Wigborough Manor
Lane,
South Petherton**

For its entire length.
The proposed date of the closure is **02nd April 2020 for 8 days**

**Creedy Bridge Road,
South Petherton**

From its junction with Lower Stratton, northwards for 150 metres.
The proposed date of the closure is **02nd April 2020 for 8 days**

This Order will enable Gigaclear to carry out a rolling programme of underground cabling works with clearing of potential duct (pipe) blockages in this road.

Statement of reasons for making the Order

- a) because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road

- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works
