Notice is hereby given that the Somerset County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 53, and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') as amended; and the Traffic Management Act 2004, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 2004') as amended, and all other enabling powers.

The effect will result in introducing the proposed restriction, permit costs and eligibility described in the Schedules below along South Esplanade, Burnham on Sea within Sedgemoor District, Somerset.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

Proposals

The introduction of permit parking on the following road, within Burnham on Sea.

**South Esplanade, Burnham on Sea Permit Parking (shared use),
Monday to Sunday, 09:00 to 18:00,
1st April to 30th September**

The existing Pay and Display of a maximum stay of 4 hours with no return within 4 hours is to remain

Reasons

Following consultation with residents of Quantock Court, Burnham On Sea it is proposed to amend the current pay and display area to a shared arrangement of pay and display and permit parking. The new permit parking will improve congestion and reduce traffic from residents' vehicles moving to comply with the current 4 hour limit.

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The specific grounds which the County Council are using for the implementation of the proposed no waiting at any time restriction as above, are the following sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

- Section 1 (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other such road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- Section 1 (c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).
- Section 1 (f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

In addition, thorough consideration was given to the factors set out in Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 in proposing this Traffic Order.

Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016

All the associated signing will be in accordance with traffic signs regulations and general directions 2016.

Equality Act 2010

Consideration was given to the equalities duty of the County Council under Section 149 of the Equality Act 2010.

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SEDGEMOOR ORDER 2012
(AMENDMENT NO. 19) ORDER 2020

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 53, and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), as amended; and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 2004"), as amended, and all other enabling powers; and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The County of Somerset prohibition and restriction of stopping, waiting, loading and unloading and on-street parking Sedgemoor Order 2012 (as amended) shall be amended by the revocation of the existing sealed plans specified in the First Schedule to this Order and which are hereby replaced with the new sealed plans specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
2. The effect of this Order is to introduce and revoke the restrictions set out in the Third Schedule to this Order.
3. The eligibility for the purchase of resident permits in accordance with the Somerset County Council permit policy is set out in the Fourth Schedule to this Order.
4. The costs for the purchase of resident permits in accordance with the Somerset County Council permit policy is set out in the Fifth Schedule to the Order.
