Schedule 1 Temporary Road Closure

High Street Bridgwater

From its junction with Regent Street to its junction with Adam Street, but not including any junctions for eastbound and

westbound traffic.

High Street Bridgwater

From its junction with South Street to its junction with Technical Street.

Schedule 2 Temporary One-Way System

Abingdon Street (Westbound) Bridgwater From its junction with Oxford Street in a westerly direction to its junction with High Street.

Adam Street (Eastbound) Bridgwater For its entire length in an easterly direction.

College Street (Westbound) Bridgwater From its junction with Victoria Street in a westerly direction to its junction with The Esplanade.

Cross Street (Westbound) Bridgwater For its entire length in a westerly direction.

Statement of reasons for making the Order

- a) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works
- b) to facilitate social distancing in shopping areas during Covid-19.
