Notice is hereby given that on the 1st of May 2020 Somerset County Council made the above order in exercise of its powers in the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as previously advertised on the 23rd April 2020 to introduce a temporary prohibition of vehicles in the road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

The Order comes into effect on the 7th of May 2020 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions will apply when indicated by traffic signs.
