Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14(2)
(21 Day Notice)
High Street, Silver Street, Middle Street and Union Street, Yeovil
Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

Somerset County Council, in exercise of its powers under section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, has issued a Notice, the effect of which is to introduce a temporary prohibition of vehicles restriction on the length of roads listed in the Schedule to this Notice.

This Notice will come into operation on the **16th June 2020** and will remain in force for a maximum of 21 days. If the works cannot be completed during that period Somerset County Council may issue a further 21-day Notice under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or make a temporary Order under Section 14(1) of that Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for a further period. The restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.

This notice is for temporary pedestrianisation to facilitate social distancing in shopping areas during Covid-19.

This Order will not apply to:

- (i) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform
- (ii) Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles
- (iii) Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations
- (iv) any vehicle being used for the purpose of maintenance of the road and operations; maintenance of street furniture and infrastructure; supply of gas, water or electricity; agriculture on any land adjacent
- (v) for residents requiring access to properties situated on or adjacent to the roads specified in this Order
- (vi) for the purpose of loading and unloading to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads specified in this Order

Schedule
Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

High Street Yeovil	For its entire length.
Silver Street Yeovil	For its entire length.
Middle Street Yeovil	From its junction with Union Street, westwards to its junction with Silver Street, for approximately 60 metres.
Union Street Yeovil	From its junction with Wine Street, northwards to its junction with Middle Street, for approximately 50 metres.

Statement of reasons for making the Order

- a) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works
or
- b) pedestrianisation to facilitate social distancing in shopping areas during Covid-19.
