Upgrading part of the footpath, CH 3/40, from the end of the unclassified county road in short distance south west of Little Hill (at approximately ST 2661 1310) to approximately ST 2613 1291 and adding a bridleway from that point (ST 2613 1291) southwards to Point C, the end of the unclassified county road (at approximately ST 2608 1275).
