Notice is hereby given that the Somerset County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') as amended; and the Traffic Management Act 2004, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 2004') as amended, and all other enabling powers.

The effect will introduce waiting restrictions, and limited waiting parking managed by permit and pay and display within the following locations known as the Galmington Trading Estate.

Taunton: Cornishway East, Cornishway North, Cornishway South, Cornishway West

Proposed charges applicable Monday to Saturday, 8.30am to 6.00pm

Estate Permits, £150 per year

Pay and Display, Up to 20 minutes: Free. £1.00 per hour, maximum stay 4 hours

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

Variation of the Somerset County Council on-street parking order 2012 (as amended), Taunton area of Somerset West and Taunton District by amending the plans to prohibit and restrict waiting within the Galmington Trading Estate area, Taunton by the introduction of pay and display / permit parking and waiting restrictions.

Proposals

The introduction of various restrictions on the following road, all within Taunton.

Cornishway East, Taunton **No waiting At Any Time**

Cornishway North, Taunton

Cornishway South, Taunton

Cornishway West, Taunton

Pay and Display – Maximum Stay 4 Hours

Monday to Saturday, 08:30 to 18:00

Permit parking

Monday to Saturday, 08:30 to 18:00

Reasons

Following feedback from the Police and businesses situated on the Trading Estate it is proposed to introduce various restrictions within the Galmington Trading Estate. No waiting at any time will deter vehicles from parking in inappropriate places, e.g. too close to junctions/access to premises and on the footway. The introduction of pay and display parking with a maximum stay of 4 hours will deter all day parking by vehicles not associated with the businesses on the estate, increase the turnover and availability of parking and improve the management of the restrictions. The introduction of a free 20-minute period for parking will enable drivers to park for short periods without charge, assisting with the drop off and collection of goods and short visits to the nearby businesses. The introduction of Estate Permits will enable employees of businesses on the estate to park without restriction.

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The specific grounds which the County Council are using for the implementation of the proposed no waiting at any time restriction as above, are the following sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

- Section 1 (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other such road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- Section 1 (c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).
- Section 1 (f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

In addition, thorough consideration was given to the factors set out in Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 in proposing this Traffic Order.

Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016

All the associated signing will be in accordance with traffic signs regulations and general directions 2016.

Equality Act 2010

Consideration was given to the equalities duty of the County Council under Section 149 of the Equality Act 2010.

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), as amended; and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 2004"), as amended, and all other enabling powers; and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The County of Somerset Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Waiting, Loading and Unloading and On-street Parking Taunton Deane Order 2012 shall be amended by the revocation of the Map Schedule specified in the First Schedule to this Order and the insertion of the Map Schedule specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
2. The effect of this Order is to introduce and revoke the restrictions set out in the Third Schedule to this Order.
3. The eligibility for the purchase of resident permits in accordance with the Somerset County Council permit policy is set out in the Fourth Schedule to this Order.
4. The costs for the purchase of resident permits in accordance with the Somerset County Council permit policy is set out in the Fifth Schedule to the Order

The remainder of the "2012 Order as amended" shall remain in full force and effect.

This Order shall come into operation on the xxxxxx 2020 and may be cited as The County of Somerset Prohibition and Restriction of Stopping, Waiting Loading and Unloading and On-street Parking Taunton Deane Order 2012 (Amendment No. 34) Order 2020.
