ORDER 2021

NOTICE is hereby given that Somerset County Council proposes to make the above Order in pursuance of the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit vehicles entering Northload Street and No Entry into Northload Street as specified in the Schedules to this Notice.

The County Council of Somerset (Northload Street (Part) Glastonbury) (Prohibition of Entry) Order 1995 is revoked.

The County Council of Somerset (Northload Street Glastonbury) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1995 is revoked.

There will be an exemption in the order for emergency services, vehicles being used in connection with any building operation, demolition in or adjacent to that road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of road of any sewer, or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity. There will also be an exemption in the order for emergency vehicles in pursuance of their duties proceeding in the lengths of road specified in the schedules to this Notice.

A copy of the draft Order, the maps showing the lengths of road affected and the Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected online at www.somerset.gov.uk/TRO.

Persons wishing to object to the proposed Order may do so in writing, specifying the grounds on which it is made, to Somerset County Council, Traffic Management by email to trafficmanagement@somerset.gov.uk , quoting Reference No. KT10122020 and received no later than 21 days from the publication of this notice.

The names and addresses of anyone writing in may be made available for public inspection and will be included in a report that may be published on the Somerset County Council website, unless the individuals concerned state, in writing, their objection to their names and addresses being made so available or being included in the publication.

SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into force on the xxth day of xxxxxxx 2021 and may be cited as "Somerset County Council (Northload Street, Glastonbury) (Parish of Glastonbury) (Revocation, Prohibition of Vehicles and No Entry) Order 2021".
2. The County Council of Somerset (Northload Street (Part) Glastonbury) (Prohibition of Entry) Order 1995 is revoked.
3. The County Council of Somerset (Northload Street Glastonbury) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1995 is revoked.
4. Except as provided in Article 6 of this Order, no person shall cause any motor vehicle to enter, proceed or wait in Northload Street, Glastonbury, as specified in in Schedule 2 to this Order.
5. Except as provided in Article 6 of this Order, no person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed against the No Entry signs on to Northload Street, Glastonbury, as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
6. Nothing in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order shall apply so as to
 - a) prevent any person from causing any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road referred to that Article if the vehicle is being used in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road so referred, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said lengths of road of any sewer, or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any apparatus as defined in Paragraph 1 (1) of the Telecommunication Code contained in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act, 1984.

- b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in the service of a local authority, the Environment Agency, a water undertaker or sewerage undertaker in pursuance of certain statutory powers or duties.
- c) prevent emergency vehicles in pursuance of their duties from proceeding in the lengths of road specified in the schedules to this Order.
- d) vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
