Notice is hereby given that on the 8th January 2021 Somerset County Council made the above order in exercise of its powers in the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as previously advertised on the 29th December 2020 to introduce a temporary prohibition of vehicles in the road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

The Order comes into effect on the 12th January 2021 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The restriction will apply when indicated by traffic signs.

Batch, north-westwards for a distance of 70 metres.
