Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, hereby makes the following Order:

This Order will come into operation on the 12<sup>th</sup> October 2020 and will remain in force for six months. The effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of vehicles and people on the footpaths specified in the Schedule to this Order. Restrictions will apply when indicated by traffic signs.

1. Except as provided in Article 3 of this Order
  - a) no person will, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle or pedal cycle to enter on, proceed or wait in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
  - b) no person will, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any foot passenger to enter on, proceed or wait in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order. "Foot passenger" includes any person driving, riding or leading a horse;
2. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order will apply to:
  - (i) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform
  - (ii) Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles
  - (iii) Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations

This Order may be cited as "Somerset County Council, Footpath from Tynte Road Bridgwater to Beech Road, Bridgwater, in the Parish of Bridgwater (Temporary Closure of Footpath) Order 2020"
