Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after communicating with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:

1. This Order will come into operation on the 19th November 2020 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions will apply when indicated by traffic signs.
2. Except as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person will cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait along the lengths of roads specified in the schedules to this Order
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order will apply to:
 - (i) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform;
 - (ii) Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles.
 - (iii) Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

This Order may be cited as Somerset County Council, District of Somerset West and Taunton Deane, Parish of Sampford Arundel, Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

**Sampford Moor
Road,
Wellington**

For a distance of approximately 640 metres. The proposed date of the closure is **23rd November 2020** until the **25th November 2020** for **3 days**.

**Ford Street,
Wellington**

For a distance of approximately 600 metres. The proposed date of the closure is **25th November 2020** until the **27th November 2020** for **3 days**.

Statement of reasons for making the Order

- a) because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road; or
- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.
