Temporary Traffic Restrictions  
Order 2020**

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, intends to make an Order, the effect of which will be to introduce the following temporary traffic restrictions as specified in the schedules to this Order.

This Order follows previous 21 day emergency notices, the works are expected to continue from the 7<sup>th</sup> December 2020 until 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020 and the restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.

This will enable Somerset Highways to facilitate social distancing in shopping areas during Covid-19.
