Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after communicating with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following order:

1. This Order will come into operation on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2020 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions will apply when indicated by traffic signs.
2. Except as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person will cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait along the lengths of roads specified in schedule to this Order
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order will apply to:
  - (i) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform;
  - (ii) Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles.
  - (iii) Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

**Schedule  
Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles**

<b>Lightgate Road, South Petherton</b>	For its entire length. The proposed date of the closure is <b>2<sup>nd</sup> November 2020 for 21 days.</b>
<b>Roundwell Street, South Petherton</b>	For its entire length. The proposed date of the closure is <b>16<sup>th</sup> November 2020 for 14 days.</b>
<b>St James Street, South Petherton</b>	From outside the property named 'Sunnybrooke', to the junction of Knapp Hill, for a distance of 105 metres in a easterly direction. The proposed date of the closure is <b>23<sup>rd</sup> November 2020 for 14 days.</b>
<b>Knapp Hill, South Petherton</b>	For its entire length. The proposed date of the closure is <b>30<sup>th</sup> November 2020 for 7 days.</b>
<b>South Street, South Petherton</b>	From junction of Knapp Hill, to junction of Coles Lane for a distance of 495 metres in a southerly direction. The proposed date of the closure is <b>7<sup>th</sup> December 2020 for 29 days.</b>
<b>Coles Lane, South Petherton</b>	For its entire length. The proposed date of the closure is <b>18<sup>th</sup> January 2021 for 14 days.</b>
<b>Hele Lane, South Petherton</b>	From the junction of South Street, to outside 'Brooklyn' and 'St. Peters', for a distance of 325 metres in a north-westerly direction. The proposed date of the closure is <b>25<sup>th</sup> January 2021 for 21 days.</b>
