(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2020
Filming – The Forge Entertainment

Somerset County Council made the above Order in exercise of the provisions of Section 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as previously advertised on the 17th December 2020, to introduce a temporary prohibition of vehicles in the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.

The Order shall come into effect at 0700 hours on 10th January 2021 and will continue in force until 2000 hours on 14th January 2021.

The Order has been made to facilitate the Filming (The Forge Entertainment) and is in the interest of public safety.

Exemptions are provided in the Order for emergency vehicles, residents requiring access and egress and any vehicles associated with the event.
