

**Schedule 1**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles (24hrs, Monday – Fridays)**

Chamberlain Street, From its junction with Priest Row, eastwards to its  
Wells junction with Sadler Street

**Schedule 2**  
**Temporary One Way (east to west direction) (outside of working hours and at weekends)**

Chamberlain Street, From its junction with Sadler Street to the junction  
Wells with Priest Row.  
(East to West direction)

**Statement of reasons for making the Order**

- a) because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road
- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works

(Temporary Traffic Restrictions) Order 2020**

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order will come into operation on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of December 2020 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions will apply when indicated by traffic signs.
2. Except as provided in Article 4 of this order no person shall except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a PCSO cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in a westerly direction on Chamberlain Street, as specified in schedule 2 to this Order.
3. Except as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person will cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait along the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order
4. Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order will apply to:
  - (i) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform
  - (ii) Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles
  - (iii) Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations
5. This Order may be cited as "Somerset County Council, Chamberlain Street, Wells, in the Parish of Wells, (Temporary Traffic Restrictions) Order 2020"
