Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order will come into operation on the 24th December 2020 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The restrictions will apply when indicated by traffic signs.
2. The right hand lane is temporarily suspended on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order
3. The right hand turn is temporarily suspended on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order
4. Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order will apply to:
 - (i) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform
 - (ii) Police, Fire and Ambulance emergency service vehicles
 - (iii) Vehicles falling within regulation 3(1), 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations
5. This Order may be cited as "Somerset County Council, Great Western Way, Taunton, in the Parish of Staplegrove, (Temporary Traffic Restrictions), Order 2020"

Temporary Right Hand Lane Closure

Great Western Way, Taunton Whole extent of the right-turn lane, in an easterly direction for 80 metres.

Schedule 2
Temporary No Right Turn

Great Western Way, Taunton Whole extent of the right-turn lane, in an easterly direction for 80 metres.

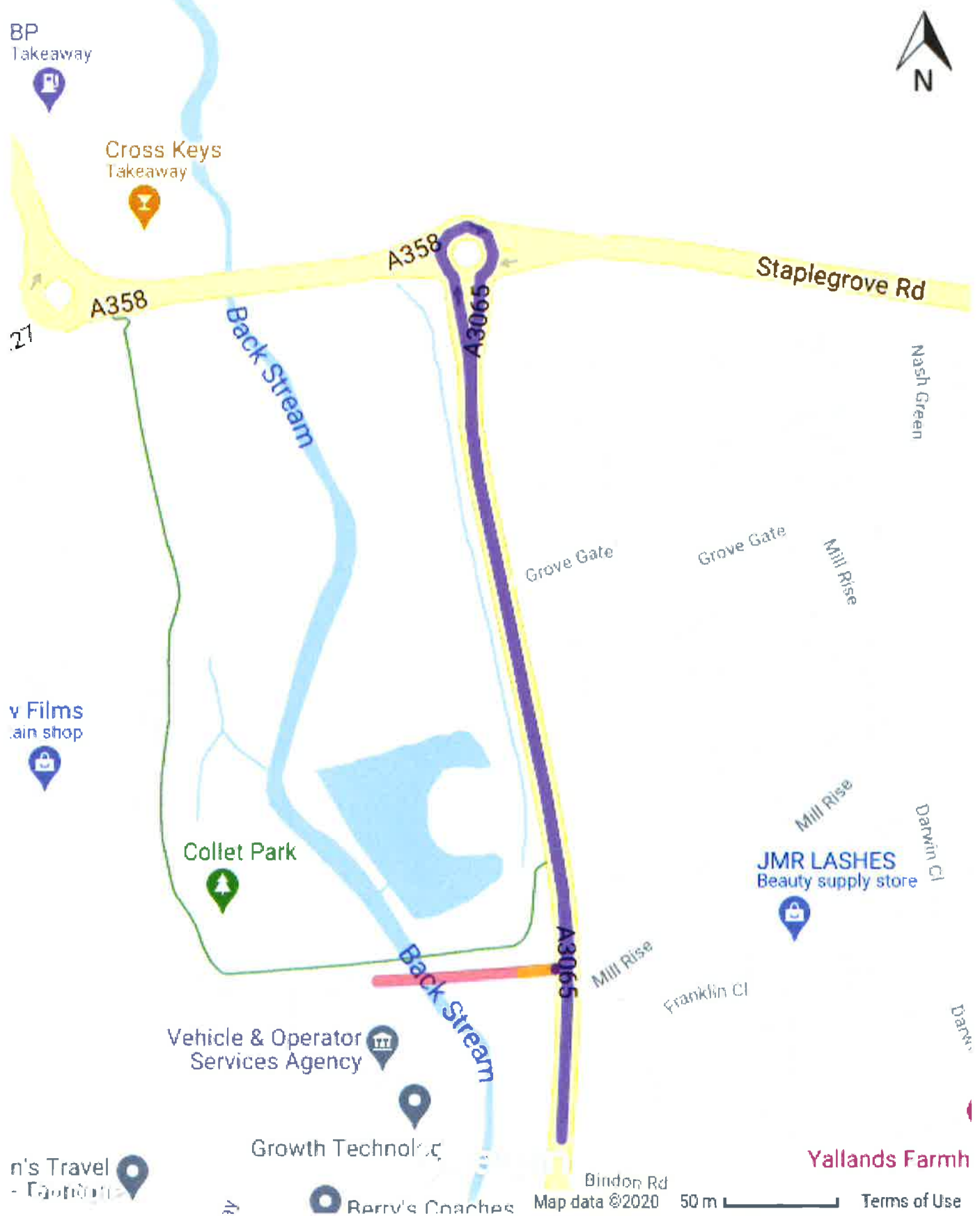
